Monroe County Clerk's Office Expands eRecord Access

131 New Document Types Can Now Be Electronically Filed in Monroe County

February 8, 2021 (Rochester, NY) Today, Monroe County Clerk Jamie Romeo announced the expansion of the Filing Office's eRecord system, adding 131 new document types for electronic recording. As the official registrar of the County, the Monroe County Clerk's Office is responsible to accept, maintain and preserve records of deeds, mortgages, assignments of mortgages, satisfactions of mortgages, judgments, and liens related to properties in Monroe County.

"The COVID-19 Pandemic has pushed a greater reliance on technology to keep parts of our economy moving, including the real estate market. This expansion of our eRecord system is another important step toward building more efficiencies as the Clerk's Office continues to find ways to bring our operations into the modern age."

As the County's Official Registrar and Clerk of the Supreme and County Courts, the Clerk's Office is the custodian of millions of land and court records. Improving safe, public access to these records remains an important objective.

"There is much of our County's legacy and history that can be learned by a review of the records we hold, however, the significant investment of funding and work required to make all of our records digitally available remains a staggering task. I am committed to finding more innovative solutions to digitize our vast archive, making them more easily accessible by the public as we seek to learn from our past, to shape our future."
